



We're Reopening!

We're excited to announce we will be reopening our doors with limited services starting on Monday, July 13. Here's what you need to know:

- Our new, temporary hours:
 - Monday – Friday: 10am – 6pm
- Face masks must be worn at all times. Thank you for understanding. If you need a face mask, we'll be happy to supply you with one. If you have a medical condition that prevents using a face mask, please call us at 924-2637 to make other arrangements.
- Building capacity will be limited.
- Please limit your time in the library to 30 minutes.
- Please limit the items you touch within the library to only those you intend to check out.
- Some public computers will be accessible, but will have a 30 minute time limit.
- All meeting rooms are temporarily closed to the public. Some of our meeting rooms are being used as storage and to quarantine items.
- We want to encourage and promote social distancing while you're in the library. Therefore, we have temporarily removed all tables and chairs.
- We have suspended all in-person programs and events, but please check out our Facebook page and YouTube channel for a variety of virtual story times, teen events, and adult events.
